

Royal Philharmonic Orchestra Codicil Form

A codicil is simply an addition or change to your Will. If you have already made a Will, you can make a simple addition to include the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra (RPO) by completing this form. The form can be completed at any time and it becomes a legal document when it is signed in the presence of two adults who, in the presence of each other, add their names as witnesses. The form should remain with your Will at all times.

The Royal Philharmonic Orchestra recommends that you take professional advice to ensure the codicil does not conflict with the rest of your will.
